Notes

1. Gardens will be judged over 3 days – the day your garden will be judged will be confirmed after all entries have been received.
 2. Paths and Lawns are included in each case.
 3. “Professional Assistance” is taken to mean the employment of a professional gardener on an hourly or day-to-day basis to help run the garden at regular intervals, as opposed to maintenance of the garden by the owner or members of the family.
 4. Garden owners will be given two minutes to introduce their garden, if they wish, before judging commences. Owners should then remain with the steward whilst the garden is being judged.
